Welcome to your National Wilderness Preservation System. Enjoy this Wilderness, but please abide by all regulations to protect and preserve the Wilderness. Help us keep the WILD in Wilderness by practicing Leave No Trace techniques.

Check with the local Ranger Station for specific regulations for the area you are entering.

**Wilderness Regulations**

- ◆ Motorized and mechanized equipment is prohibited, including motorbikes, bicycles, chainsaws, carts, hang gliders, aircraft and other non-primitive modes of transportation.
- ◆ Do not cut switchbacks. Stay on established trails.
- ◆ Do not cut trees, snags or boughs. Please use dead and down wood if you need to have a campfire.
- ◆ Do not walk or camp in areas closed for restoration. These areas have been replanted to restore natural conditions.
- ◆ Practice "No Trace" camping and leave the Wilderness cleaner than when you found it.
- ◆ Bury human and pet waste well away from camps and water sources. Dispose of wash water away from water sources.
- ◆ Unprocessed hay, grain or other forms of livestock feeds are prohibited. Any livestock feed that may serve as a seed source for non-native plants is considered unprocessed.
- ◆ Do not build structures of any kind. They detract from the natural beauty of Wilderness.

**WENATCHEE NATIONAL FOREST**

- ◆ Permits are required for entering Wilderness on the Wenatchee National Forest, Naches Ranger District. Permits are used to collect visitor use information.
- ◆ The group size limit is 12. Any combination of persons and pack or saddle stock exceeding 12 is prohibited. Groups exceeding the size allowed must separate and maintain a 1 mile separation while hiking and camping.
- ◆ Caching or storing supplies or equipment for more than 48 hours is prohibited.
- ◆ Please select an existing, screened campsite at least 100 feet away from lakes.
- ◆ Campfires are prohibited within 1/4 mile of Goat Lake, within Snowgrass Flats, and within Shoe Lake Basin in the Goat Rocks Wilderness. Campfires are also prohibited within 1/4 mile of Dewey Lakes in the William O. Douglas Wilderness.
- ◆ Grazing, hitching or tethering of stock within 200 feet of lakes or within Snowgrass Flats is prohibited.
